

# RHODA PATTERSON

Rhoda was born in St. Louis County on April 1, 1804. She married Thomas Lillard in St. Louis County on January 1, 1821.

Thomas Lillard was born in Culpeper County, Virginia on December 28, 1792.

They moved from the area and settled first in Calhoun County, Illinois and later moved to Decatur County, Iowa where they both died.

Thomas died April 16, 1881 and Rhoda died September 29, 1887. Both are buried in the Garden Grove Cemetery in Decatur County, Iowa.

## **John Wesley Lillard**

He was born in St. Louis County, Missouri April 4, 1821.

## **Augustine Lillard**

Augustine was born in St. Louis County on February 7, 1823.

## **Elizabeth Lillard**

Elizabeth was born in St. Louis County on October 20, 1824.

## **Sarah Emeline Lillard**

Sallie was born in St. Louis County June 20, 1826.

## **William E. Lillard**

William was born in St. Louis County October 20, 1828.

## **Sanders P. Lillard**

Sanders was the last child born in Missouri. He was born August 15, 1830.

## **David Patterson Lillard**

David was born February 15, 1834 in Calhoun County, Illinois.

## **Mary Ann Lillard**

Mary was born June 19, 1836. She died before the 1850 census.

## **Henry Louis Lillard**

Henry was born in Calhoun County June 1, 1838. He married Mary Almeda McVey February 8, 1862 in Iowa. He died of smallpox while serving in the Civil War. He was in the Union Army and was a prisoner guard on board a ship on the Mississippi near St. Louis. They had one son:

**HENRY LOUIS LILLARD, JR.** born December 6, 1862 in Garden Grove, Iowa. He married Mary Johnson March 11, 1886, and they had three children: Mary, Lena, and Maurice Lillard.

## **James Monroe Lillard**

James was born in Calhoun County on February 16, 1840.

## **Hiram B. Lillard**

Hiram was born March 28, 1842 and died before the 1850 census.

## **Lydia Lillard**

She was born in Calhoun County February 9, 1844 and died before 1850.
